

## COVID-19 SAILING GUIDELINES

1. **Avoid congregating in common sailing areas** where boat equipment and accessories are located. If necessary, form a line and wait your turn. Pack your gear and supplies ahead of time and don't spend extra time at the boat racks, in the locker room, or near your car.
2. Only **two persons** may be in the locker room at a time. Keep a six foot distance from each other and wear a face covering while inside.
3. It is best to use your own equipment, but if you are sharing equipment –**before use - you need to spray or wipe down the boat and any accessories (mast, rudder, center board, ropes/sheets, etc...)** with NSYC provided disinfectant, located in the locker room. No NSYC life jackets or wetsuits will be available so bring your own.
4. **Wear face coverings** (cloth masks preferred) over nose and mouth in indoor spaces, as well as outdoors when a six foot distance from others cannot be maintained. On the water, for safety, face coverings can be removed and stowed in a dry bag for safety purposes.
5. Sunfish hulls are located in the parking lot on the lower racks and dollies are nearby on the beach. Larger sailboats are located in the south parking lot. Wear face coverings if you require others to assist you with moving your boat or accessories. **Wash or sanitize your hands often after touching surfaces others may have touched.**
6. When several sailors are launching or rigging and unrigging their boats, **give those near you plenty of time and space (6 feet minimum)** to finish launching or rigging and unrigging before you approach or you can set up at a significant distance from them.
7. All NSYC rules remain in effect. Always wear your life jacket and boat with a buddy. **When on the water, do not "raft up" with other boats** or pull up onto a beach close to other people, as that could put you in close proximity with others.
